As soon as the opposing team shot is past the hogline, your teams next player should enter the hack and prepare the rock to be thrown as soon as the Skip places his broom, and indicates they are ready for your shot.

Start On Time

Have your team on the ice, with a completed coin toss, and be hack ready, PRIOR to the bell at 7:00 P.M or 9:15 P.M. for night games. The same applies for other game start times.

Immediately after the bell sounds the first rock should be thrown
